Maintenance Selection System Handbook

The MSS Handbook EL-304 has been revised as of June 1, 2009 and we now have a Revamped Maintenance Selection System (RMSS). The new handbook and agreement will be posted to our local web page APWUPVD.ORG in the Maintenance Corner. This language effects how most maintenance craft positions are filled, both in-craft and in-service.

There will only be one exam for the positions covered – Exam 955, and it will be administered online.

Craft members placed on the Promotion Eligible Registers (PER) under the old MSS will remain on the registers above members placed on the list under the RMSS.

The KSA booklet will not be used under the new system.

The supervisors evaluation has been removed from the new process and the review panel has been renamed Interview Panel. The panel must complete a result form and make it available to the employee on request.

Maintenance Craft members will be allowed to update every 120 days. The requirement of extra training has been replaced with language that the test will not be given to an employees within 120 of that employees previous exam. Note that the 37 days the service has to complete the update process remains.
