UNION MEETING MINUTES; SUNDAY, APRIL 17, 2011

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 10AM BY PRESIDENT MATHIEU. AFTER THE MORNING PRAYER AND SALUTE TO THE FLAG A ROLL CALL OF OFFICERS AND STEWARDS WAS TAKEN... THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE ACCEPTED BY THE MEMBERS....KELLY GAVE THE TREASURERS REPORT. WE ARE IN GOOD FINANCIAL SHAPE. PRESIDENTS REPORT: RON REMINDS EVERYONE TO VOTE. IF YOU DID NOT RECEIVE A BALLOT CONTACT THE NATIONAL YOUR VOTE IS IMPORTANT. RON SPOKE OF A SCHEDULED MEETING WITH CUSTOMER SERVICES. RON THANKS RAY AND STEVE FOR MAKING SURE OF THAT. A LENGTHY DISCUSSION TOOK PLACE CONCERNING JOB PLACEMENT, VETERANS RIGHTS, MSPD RIGHTS. YOUR UNION REPS WON'T ALLOW ANYONE TO SLIP THROUGH THE CRACKS. YOU MUST REMEMBER THAT MANAGEMENT STILL WANTS TO REDUCE THE WORKFORCE ANYWAY POSSIBLE.... VICE-PRESIDENTS REPORT: RAY SPOKE ON THE SAME SUBJECTS. HE URGES ANYONE UNASSIGNED TO BID ON A JOB...ALSO GET THE VOTE OUT. THE PROPOSED CONTRACT HAS A LOT OF HOLES IN IT, THEY CHANGED THE WORDING ON CASUALS TO PSE'S BUT EVERYONE SHOULD READ THE CONTRACT SENT THEM BEFORE VOTING. CLERK-CRAFT DIRECTOR; STEVE REPORTS THE SAVING OF MANY JOBS AND PRAISES HIS STEWARDS FOR THE FINE WORK THEY ARE PERFORMING FOR THE MEMBERS. LOCAL NEGOTIATIONS WILL BE COMING UP IF THE CONTRACT IS RATIFIED, WE HAVE TO BE READY FOR THIS... MAINTENANCE CRAFT; JOHN MORAN REPORTS (LLOYD IS ON ANNUAL). A LOT OF THE CUSTODIAL ROUTES ARE NOT BEING COMPLETED. JOHN URGES THE MEMBERS TO DO THEIR WORK AND NOT SOMEONE ELSES. DIRECTOR OF ORGANIZATION; ANN REMINDS EVERYONE TO COME TO THE MAY BREAKFAST ON SATURDAY, MAY 7TH.....ALWAYS A GOOD TIME. 028 STEWARDS REPORT; BOB DONAHUE REPORTS THAT HE THINKS THE NEW CONTRACT WILL CAUSE PROBLEMS WITH THE 30-HOUR WORK WEEK.
